With grateful hearts

Today's first reading from 2 Kings recounts the story of Naaman, a high ranking commander from Aram who suffered from leprosy. Despite his affliction, Naaman's humility in following the instructions of the prophet Elisha led him to experience God's healing presence in his life. In gratitude, Naaman vowed to worship only the God of Israel. In the Gospel, we encounter ten lepers who approached Jesus seeking healing. Although all ten were healed, only one returned to Jesus to express his gratitude.

These two readings encourage us to reflect on our hearts: Are we truly grateful to God for His gifts and His loving presence? Often, we focus on our failures, disappointments, and sufferings, neglecting to appreciate and thank God for all He has done for us and given us. Our loving God is always by our side. His strength helps us through difficult times, His joy uplifts us when we are down, His light guides us in our lives, and His peace comforts us in our sorrows. Let us strive to be humble and recognise God's loving presence in every aspect of our lives, giving thanks to Him with grateful hearts. Gratitude leads us to a deeper relationship with God.
