Serve God, not money

In the first reading, the prophet Amos says, “Listen to this, you who trample on the needy and try to suppress the poor people of the country...The Lord swears it by the pride of Jacob, “Never will I forget a single thing you have done”.

Amos wants the people to understand that God cares about every individual, especially the poor and the vulnerable. He sees every act of dishonesty, indifference and injustice.

This message is relevant for us today as well. Our Catholic faith goes beyond attending Mass or volunteering at parishes; it calls us to be kind and compassionate and engage meaningfully with the world. We are urged to treat everyone with fairness, recognising their inherent dignity, and to offer compassion to those in need.

In the gospel, Jesus tells a parable about a steward who gets into trouble by focusing on accumulating wealth for himself. He then shifts his focus to building relationships instead. Jesus concludes by saying, “You cannot serve both God and money.” While wealth itself is not inherently bad, the love of money can blind us to the needs of those around us. Today, Jesus invites us to put God first above all else and to use our resources to support and care for those in need, particularly the poor.

Reflective question:

Am I attentive to the needs of those around us, especially the poor and the vulnerable in society?

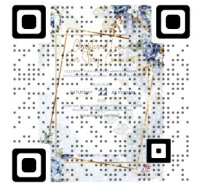
