

耶稣复活主日 20/04/2025

今天的福音章节取自路加福音(路廿四13-35), 记述的是复活主 如何在前往厄玛乌的路上显现给两位门徒。这个故事充满了戏剧性、丰富的情感、神秘性、以及神学性。作者以高明的记述手法给我们呈现出 这个故事。释经学者把这个故事的记述分成四个部分: (一)相遇(13-16节);(二)交谈对话(17-27节);(三)在 厄玛乌的晚餐(28-32节);(四)门徒回到耶路撒冷(33-35节)。路 加藉着这故事来给他的团体回答一个很重要的问题。我们这些没有生活在主耶稣同时代的人, 不能经验到光荣复活的耶稣, 这是不是一件太遗憾的事呢? 路加的回答是: 即使我们不是活在主耶稣的时代, 复活主仍 然有可能显现给我们。 《梵蒂冈广播电台文稿》

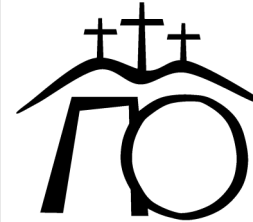

The Empty Tomb

"This day was made by the Lord, we rejoice and are glad" (The Responsorial Psalm). On Easter Sunday and every day of our lives, we can rejoice because Jesus is not dead but alive; not absent but present with us. On Good Friday, the authorities silenced Him because they could not

tolerate His radical values that challenged the status quo and stirred the hearts of many. His message of love, truth and justice clashed with their interests, and so they hung Him. However, Jesus did not stay dead. In today's gospel, the three disciples, Mary Magdalene, John and Peter saw the empty tomb and did not fully understand what happened. Today, we are invited to ponder on the message of the empty tomb. What does it mean for us today? It tells us that when conflicts, violence, suffering and death seem to be in control, there is another power at work that brings peace out of conflict, joy out of suffering, life out of death.

Today, let us rejoice because we know for certain that God's love conquers all.

Reflective question: What is Jesus' message to me in this time of prayer?
