To be a blessing for others

In today's Gospel for the Feast of the Assumption, we see Mary fully giving herself to God. Her "yes" at the Annunciation immediately becomes a "yes" in action: she quickly goes to help her cousin, Elizabeth. She does not focus on herself, but on what God wants and how she can help. Out of love, she offers her whole life - her body, time, plans and feelings - to God. She trusts God and lets His word shape her future, her relationships and her understanding of who she is for Him. As she says, "He has looked upon his lowly handmaid. ..." Mary does not hold anything back; she belongs to God, and because of this, she brings blessings to others.

As Mary sings the Magnificat, she does not boast of what she has done; instead, she magnifies what God has done in her. This is the source of her joy. Because she has given herself completely to God, her heart 18 expands, allowing her to see the needs of others, especially the poor and lowly. Today, let us follow Mary's example by giving our lives to God. When we do this, our joy grows, our hearts widen, and our lives become a quiet blessing for others.

Reflective question: What is one concrete way I can be a blessing to those around me, as Mary was?
