在福音中，耶稣讲了富翁与拉匝禄的比喻，说明富翁因为只夸耀财富，无视他家门口的乞丐拉匝禄的存在，没有与人分享来自天主的财富和爱，而在死后与天主的爱相隔离，不得享受天堂的福乐。
