

复活期第三主日 14/04/2024

在今天的福音中，耶稣基督再次显现给门徒们，让他们认出祂确实就是天主的默西亚。我们马上可以观察到耶稣基督与圣经固有的紧密联系，以及连带的救恩讯息。一方面，我们需要基督来给我们讲解圣经；另一方面，我们也需要借着圣经来认识基督；还有更重要的一点是，无论我们要理解圣经、或是要认识基督，我们都必须有信德；因为信德使我们的理解拥有真理的凭证，信德是正确理解救恩的焦点，信德使我们心眼合一。今天取自《若望一书》的读经二，又从真理和爱的观点加以解释说：「那说『我认识基督，』而不遵守祂命令的人，在他心内就没有真理；但是，谁若遵守祂的话，天主的爱在他内才得以圆满」（若一：二4）。「遵守」在这里的意思就是「因信德而生活」，以信仰接纳真理；如此，在内心中就会有真理，也能享有天主的爱。

Experiencing Jesus alive

In their state of alarm and fright, the disciples could not see and believe that Jesus was real and alive. They needed Jesus to show them that He was truly risen. Patiently, He brought them to experience Him living and present in their midst: “Look at my hands and feet...Touch me and see for yourselves.” He opened their minds to understand His words and actions: “...the Christ would suffer and on the third day rise from the dead...”. With the same patience, Jesus never stops bringing us to experience Him alive and present, reassuring us that we are not alone as we walk through life. In moments of suffering, Jesus accompanies us as someone who knows by experience what suffering means. We feel His closeness through the acts of love from those around us and in the Eucharist. His Word lights our way so we can follow Him with faith and understanding. Let us then be strengthened to give witness through how we walk in hope with the risen Jesus.

Reflective question:

How have I experienced Jesus alive today?
