你们就是这些事的见证人。中国古语云：独乐乐不若与众乐乐（孟子，梁惠王下）。我们领受了复活的喜讯，更负有分享这美好事物的责任。很多人以为，我们去宣讲复活就好了，但不同于马尔谷福音大使命派遣（参考谷十六15-19）的是，耶稣今天要门徒们去做“见证”。见证与宣讲不同。宣讲更多是讲述、传播，而见证却更多的要求我们的生活要与所宣信的一致，否则我们的见证就是无力的，我们的宣讲也是空洞的。见证本身还包含着，我们自己已经经历过，体验到了，所以我们才去讲给别人；我已经知道这是确切的，真实的，美好的，所以我也想让别人来分享这一切。复活的见证是包含着平安、喜乐、宽恕、包容、温和、善良……等所有因素的一种生活，不只是祈祷后的暂时轻松，而是每天的日常生活。

The empty tomb

“Then the other disciple who had reached the tomb first also went in; he saw and he believed”. When Mary of Magdala told them that the tomb was empty, Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved and the one who stood faithfully at His cross, run to the tomb. Peter went in the tomb and could not understand what was happening. The other disciple went in, saw what Peter saw and he believed. On this Easter Sunday, we are invited to open our eyes and look at the empty tombs in our lives with eyes of faith, like the beloved disciple. Faith is essential to help us make sense of this life, perceive that God is with us and is at work in us, and trust that He wants to bring joy where there is sadness, light where there is darkness, and life where there is death. Thus, we can see the empty tombs in our lives and just see them as emptiness, or we can see them with faith and know that we are not alone in facing our empty tombs because Jesus is not dead but alive and has left His tomb to be with us.

Reflective question: What blocks me from having Easter faith?

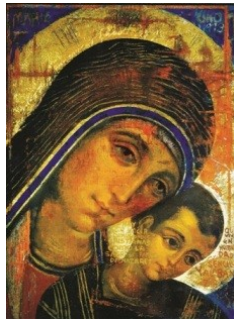
