Prophets of today

"The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet...to him you must listen" (1st reading). One listens to a prophet because he/she is called to speak God's word to the people. However, firstly, a prophet has to listen deeply to God because He leads us to be in touch with the realities of others. Jesus Himself did this in the gospel when He healed the possessed man. He listened and saw someone who was not free inside to be himself and live life to the fullest. Understanding the man's suffering, Jesus spoke the word that freed and restored him to true life. As Christians, we are called to share in the prophetic role of Jesus. We are the prophets of to-

day: in our places and among the people God has given us. God wants to speak His word of healing and freedom to His people through us. Desiring the same, let us listen to God so that, in turn, we can speak His word to those suffering.

Reflective question:

Am I living my Christian calling as a prophet of today?


