四旬期第四主日

天主赐下自己的独生子,派遣祂到世界上来,完全且纯粹是为了救 赎人类:审判和定罪并不是天主的原意。那么,我们又该如何理解审判 和定罪呢?就如梅瑟在旷野中高举铜蛇,那些被毒蛇咬了的人,一瞻仰 铜蛇, 就保存了生命(户廿一9), 而那些不瞻仰铜蛇的, 就丧失性命; 同样的, 基督被举起在十字架上, 那些信而瞻仰基督的人也都要保存生 命,不信而不瞻仰基督的人就丧失性命。基督是照亮世界的真光;祂使 **所有接受祂的救恩的人成为天主的儿女。但是,人必**须选择**接受**祂,选 择趋向光明,并在光明和爱的道路上行走,相信祂确实就是唯一能走到 天主跟前的道路。耶稣说:「我是道路、真理、生命,除非经过我,谁 也不能到父那里去」(若十四6)。因此,审判和定罪的成立就在於人 自己的抉择:选择光明和生命的,就处在光明和生命中;拒绝光明和生 命的,就处在黑暗和死亡中。
