Jesus' activity: God and people

As we pray with the gospels, more and more, we submerge ourselves into the life of Jesus, in his ins and outs, His daily activities, and His motivations behind them. We can see how His heart is with God and the people. He absorbs the love of God, and He transmits it to those who are with Him in many different ways, for example, sometimes healing their sickness and other times talking to them about God, either personally or as a group. But his energy, compassion, and motivation come from those long moments in solitude that He spends in dialogue with the Father. God is the one who moves His heart and will, indicating to Him what step to take next. In today's gospel, we learn from Jesus that we need to have those quiet moments in which we ask Him how to go about in the situations we live in and what way to take. We learn how to make God the source of our daily energy in order to deal with the people and the situations we will face.

Reflective question:

Do I count on God as the source of my strength in my daily life?
