By the Sea of Galilee, Peter, Andrew, James and John experienced Jesus walking right into their lives, meeting them where they were in life, and speaking words that gave them true direction and new purpose. 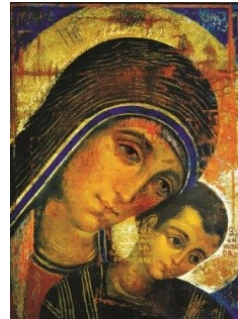
