Riding on a donkey

"He humbled himself' ... These words show us God's way and, consequently, that which must be the way of Christians: it is humility. A way which constantly amazes and disturbs us: we will never get used to a humble God! Humility is above all God's way: God humbles himself to walk with his people ... This week, Holy Week, which leads us to Easter, we will take this path of Jesus' own humiliation. Only in this way will this week be 'holy' for us too!" (Pope Franics, Palm Sunday homily, 30 th March 2015) In the Roman Empire, kings would ride on mighty stallions into the city in a triumphant procession to display their power, authority. and wealth. However, Jesus rode on a young donkey, reflecting His humility and gentleness. This is our humble God. The crowd welcomed Jesus with joy and enthusiasm. Yet, soon, they would turn against Him and shout. "Crucify Him!". How fickle their hearts! Do we follow Jesus enthusiastically even if it leads us to the path of humiliation? Today is a call for us to put aside our pride that looks for recognition, self-glory, and popularity and follow Jesus with humility.

Reflective question: What is Jesus' message to me?
